## COVID-19 and Impact on Programs (Dec 7. 2020)

In response to the ICU capacity in the Southern California Region falling below 15%, the Regional Stay Home Order was implemented at 11:59 pm. This has prompted renewed questions about Scouting programs and what can remain open.

In consultation with the State of California and local health departments, we discussed that the mental and physical health of our youth is critical at this time and confirmed the following:

- Day Camps (OCBSA matrix) remain open during the Regional Stay Home Order following the industry guidance including Youth Cohorts.
- Youth Sports remain open during the Regional Stay Home Order following the industry guidance including Youth Cohorts.
- Day Camps and Youth Sports are closed from 10 pm to 5 am during the Limited Stay Home Order and Regional Stay Home Order.
- All overnight camping is closed during the Regional Stay Home Order.
- Scout Shops remain open at 20% capacity during the Regional Stay Home Order.

At this time, we ask all of our members and their families to use extreme caution and to follow all guidance from our state and local health departments. We encourage you to utilize the five simple points that Dr. Anthony Fauci, Director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Disease, is championing and is consistent in all California guidance:

- Wear a mask consistently and correctly
- Avoid crowds
- Stay six feet apart
- Opt for the outdoors
- Wash your hands

Thank you again for your partnership, flexibility and patience as we navigate this challenging and unprecedented chapter in our council's history together. As we have since the onset of COVID-19, we will continue to closely monitor this situation and follow guidelines from expert health agencies, while keeping our Scouting community informed.

#### **Program Delivery Updates**

#### **Eagle Boards of Review**

In-person boards can be conducted following these guidelines. It is important to note that it is up to the candidate, not the board, as to the format between an in-person or virtual board of review. Both must be offered to candidates.

#### **Chapter Activities/Meetings/Banquets**

Chapter meetings are more like unit meetings than like adult meetings and are direct program delivery. As such, chapters are now authorized to resume in person activities and chapter meetings in line with the guidance in the Unit Restart Guide. Chapter banquets however remain in the Meetings & Conferences industry and as such are currently closed to in-person events. These can be postponed or delivered virtually.

#### **Den and Patrol Meetings at Council Camps**

We understand many units are struggling to find a location to resume in-person activities. Recent changes in State guidelines allows the council to offer our properties temporarily for den and patrol meetings during the week. Units must follow guidelines in the Unit Restart Guidebook (https://www.ocbsa.org/wp-

<u>content/uploads/Unit-Restart-Guidebook-1.pdf</u>) and those for the property to ensure the safety of all participants and staff.

Currently, space is available only at the Irvine Ranch Outdoor Education Center and Oso Lake Scout Camp. The council reserves the right to revoke/cancel this privilege due to non-compliance of the guidelines, change in state/county guidelines, and council operations at any time and without notice.



## New BSA Fees for 2021 & Recharter Information



Starting August 1, 2020 BSA National and Orange County Council have announced new fees associated with registering youth and adults in the Scouting program.

New fees are summarized as follows:

New Member Joining Fee: Youth Only – one time \$25 flat fee no matter when you join during the year (no prorating). Fee is in addition to above enrollment fee. There is NO joining fee for adult volunteers, Exploring participants, or any member previously registered in any BSA programs.

Unit Recharter Fee: \$75 for all new and rechartering units.

Please continue to support Scouting. Even with these changes BSA quality programs are still bargain priced when compared with other activities such as soccer, baseball and football (see below). Also, let's not forget that Scouting delivers immeasurable lasting value to our youth and families as well. It still remains an inexpensive investment in a future for our youth.

**Eagle Palms** Once a Scout has earned his Eagle Rank, he may receive his Palms for every 5 MB's over the 21 for Eagle. Example: A Scout earned 36 MB's at the time of earning Eagle Rank. He may receive a Bronze Palm, for 5, Gold Palm for 5, and a Silver Palm for 5, totaling 36 MB's. Following earning Eagle, every 3 months and 5 MB's he may receive an additional Palm, B,S,G, until their 18<sup>th</sup> Birthday. These may be presented at the Eagle Court of Honor.

**Scoutbook** New apps for your computer or Smartphone. App allows access to Units training, rosters, calendar, announcements, a link to BSA materials and commissioner tools. If you would like to try it, type **"myscouting"** in your device's app store.

Due to Units not processing achievements within a week of earning, i.e. Rank advancement or Merit Badges Earned, the National Database is not updated to reflect actual achievements. You may record a Scouts achievement in "Scoutbook" for Cub Scouts, or Advancement in "my.scouting.org.

To learn on your own how to use Scoutbook, go to Scoutbook.com and use your my.scouting.org username and password to log in. There are applications for every registered position in scouting, including parent, on how to use Scoutbook for the level of access you have based on your BSA position.

## Training New requirement



from BSA is to have all Scouters trained in their registered position before Chartering for 2020.

We are currently about 77% trained in our district. If you are a registered adult, you must be trained whether as a committee member or Scoutmaster/assistant scoutmaster or cub leader, venturing leader, etc.. Everybody must be YPT trained:

- Please complete YPT even if it's not due for a few months. Please help the overload rush in the fall and winter. YPT Training: Visit <u>my.scouting.org</u> to logon and take your YPT training TODAY! After login, select MENU, My TRAINING, Training Center, select your Program, and training for your position.
- If you have incomplete training, you will need to restart with the new updated training at the national level. We will be updating our own District training videos to reflect those changes. Visit <u>https://training.scouting.org/catalog</u> (Login required) to view your program and position specific training.
- Every scout needs and deserves a trained adult leader. It is required and expected that you complete your specific leader training that you are willing to serve at. Thank you for all that you do to serve our youth.

- All the DEN LEADER training is the same 22 modules.
- CUBMASTER has the same modules as the DEN LEADER plus eight more.
- PACK COMMITTEE TRAINING has the 22 modules of a different mix of the total 30 modules.

We are planning on putting on the 5 Leader Specific Training in a YouTube video with the most helpful Joe

Lum. SM is 6 hours long in 3 segments, all others are 3 hours.

Merit Badge Counselor Training is now online at My.Scouting.Org. Our District Advancement Chair will get all our MBC's



trained in that position. All MBC's are required to have a current YPT2 to registered in 2020.
