THINK SMALL! Dens and Patrols. Meet at parks, church parking lots, front yards. Scouts can meet in person as of June 8, 2020 as long as: They have the permission of the Charter Organization, Committee Chairperson and Scout Master. No Scout is required to attend in-person meetings. Units follow social distancing (6-feet), have hand washing stations and everyone is properly wearing a face mask. - **Modified Camping Requirements for 2021 Election Cycle**

The nights camped to be eligible to become a candidate for the Order of the Arrow remain at 15 nights within the last 24 months prior to your election date, however for this year

the requirement that 5 of the 15 nights must be a long term camp has been relaxed. Meaning that if a Scout has completed 15 nights camping in only short term camps within the

24 months leading up to the unit's election, he or she is eligible to become a candidate of the Order of the Arrow.
