Modified Camping Requirements for 2021 Election Cycle

- The nights camped to be eligible to become a candidate for the Order of the Arrow remain at 15 nights within the last 24 months prior to your election date, however for this year
- the requirement that 5 of the 15 nights must be a long-term camp has been relaxed. Meaning that if a Scout has completed 15 nights camping in only short term camps within the 24 months leading up to the unit's election, he or she is eligible to become a candidate of the Order of the Arrow.

Ordeals and Brotherhood Events

- Ordeals are NO longer single day events. We have returned to having the overnight component.
- The next Ordeal/Brotherhood Events will be August 20th-21st at IROEC and October 15th-16th TBD
