Scout is Kind

The Orange County Council, BSA is joining kindness forces with the Girl Scouts of Orange County and the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) to participate in "One Billion Acts of Kindness." This special initiative, launched by OCDE Superintendent, Dr. Al Mijares, has the potential to be a serious game changer for our children and the entire county. We are asking every Scout and Scout leader to commit to one act of kindness every day in November in an effort to establish a trend that will last the entire school year. If all 50,000 Girl Scout and Boy Scout members do just one act of kindness each day for 30 days in November, we will log 1.5 million acts of kindness! That's a game changer!

It's as easy as doing one act of kindness and then logging it on the 1BAK website: kindness1billion.org. As all Scouts know, "A Scout is Kind" is the sixth point of the Scout Law, so we believe our Scouts and leaders already pro-actively work out this virtue. All we need to do now is log it and make it contagious. Imagine the impact in our communities as our Scouts lead the way in kindness, on their school campuses, in their neighborhoods, on the ball fields and encouraging other friends to join in.



Membership: No. 1, submit new applications within 7 days of being signed. No. 2, Adults complete YPT within 7 days.



Advancement: We have 8 earning their Eagle Scout rank and 40 in work for their Eagle Board of Reviews this month. for a total of 8 in Golden West for 2020. We had 51 El Capitan Eagles in 2019. 54 for 2018, 28 for 2017, 31 in 2016, 58 in 2015, and 54 in 2014 in the El Capitan District. We look forward to receiving the former Orange Frontier District historical data to give us a combined total.

Unit may not add, subtract, or change requirements or processes for Rank Advancement. All requirements are specified in the BSA Advancement Guide.

Eagle Palms: Once a Scout has earned his Eagle Rank, he may receive his Palms for every 5 MB's over the 21 for Eagle. Example: A Scout earned 36 MB's at the time of earning Eagle Rank. He may receive a Bronze Palm, for 5, Gold Palm for 5, and a Silver Palm for 5, totaling 36 MB's. Following earning Eagle, every 3 months and 5 MB's he may receive an additional Palm, B,S,G, until their 18th Birthday. These may be presented at the Eagle Court of Honor.

Due to Units not processing achievements within a week of earning, i.e. Rank advancement or Merit Badges

Earned, the National Database is not updated to reflect actual achievements. You may record a Scouts achievement in "Scoutbook" for Cub Scouts, or Advancement in my.scouting.org.
